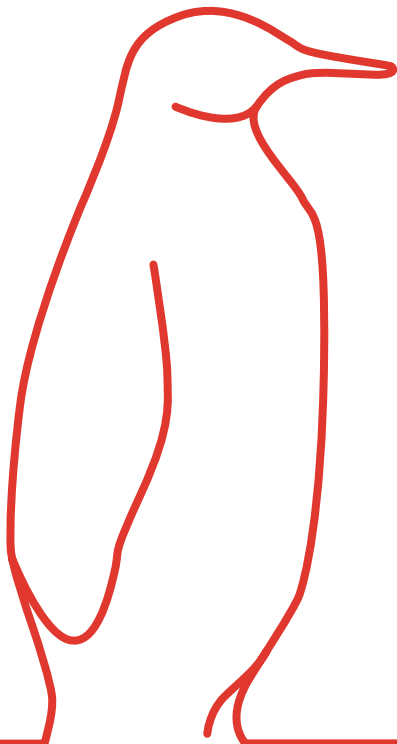

POOL

- The pool is an 8-lane 25m deck level pool
- Anti-turbulence lane ropes
- Electronic timing
- Warm up/swim down facilities available throughout the meet

ENTRY DATES AND FEES

Entries open: Monday, 4th May 2026.

Entries close: Friday 26th June 2026.

Individual entry fee is £8 per 50m/100m/200m event and £10 per 400m event. Relay fee is £16.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

At the time of submitting their entry swimmers must be registered with their governing body as competitors for the club they wish to represent. For Swim England that is "Club Compete" and for members of Swim Wales it is Category 2. A competitor may only compete for one club in the competition. Temporary members will not be accepted.

Entries will be accepted on a first come first served basis. Should the meet become oversubscribed, the promoter reserves the right to close the entries early.

Entries will not be accepted until the full payment has been received.

INDIVIDUAL EVENTS

The individual events shall be (for both male/open and female):

50m, 100m, 200m, 400m freestyle

50m, 100m and 200m backstroke, breaststroke, and butterfly

100m, 200m, 400m individual medley

Age groups are 18 to 24 years old, and from 25 years old in 5-year age bands up to 90 years and over. Ages are as of 31st December 2025.

All competitors must be 18 years of age or older on 4th July 2026.

All results will be decided on a heat declared basis.

Medals will be awarded to individuals placed 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in each age group.

WARWICKSHIRE MASTERS CHAMPION

A Warwickshire Masters Champion will be awarded to the top performing individual in the male/open category and female category.

This will be decided by the following criteria:

- Individual must be registered with and competing for a Warwickshire based swimming club at the Kenilworth Masters Open Meet
- Competing in a minimum of 3 individual events

Top place will be awarded to the individual who has accumulated the most Decathlon points for their highest scoring 3 events.

RELAY

Relay ages are 72+, 100+, 120+, 160+, 200+, 240+.

Swimmers participating in relay events must be eligible to enter individual events. Relay ages are the combined ages of team members.

The minimum age for an individual swimmer in any age group is 18. Mixed events must include 2 male/open and 2 female swimmers.

Relay declaration forms must include Swim England registration numbers (or equivalent).

Relay declaration forms must be submitted no later than 20 minutes before the start of the warm ups.

COMPETITION ENTRY PROCEDURE

Members of all other clubs should check their registration status with their national organisation.

If you submit an entry and you are not a registered competitive member of your national governing body your entry will be cancelled and your entry fee will be forfeited.

The promoter will limit the number of entries should the event be oversubscribed.

EVENTS AND SEEDING

Open/Male and Female swimmers will swim together in the same heats. Events will be seeded in order of entry time, irrespective of age, from slowest to fastest. The fastest heat in each event will be spearheaded. Swimmers must submit an entry time in order to complete the online entry process.

HEAT SHEETS

Heat sheets will be posted at the pool before the start of each session and be available online at the Kenilworth Masters website. There will not be a programme available on the day.

RESULTS

Results will be decided on heat times, there will be no finals. They will be available online and updated after each event has been completed.

WITHDRAWALS & REFUNDS

Refunds will not be given for swimmers withdrawing after the closing date or for any errors or omissions attributable to the individual or their club.

Refunds will only be given to individuals who can prove that they are unfit to compete on medical grounds subject to an appropriate medical certificate being received by the Meet Promoter.

PRIZE MONEY

British record breakers will share a £250 prize fund.

Each individual who breaks a British record in their age group will earn one share of the £250 prize fund. There is no limit to the number of records an individual can break and therefore no limit to the number of shares they can earn.

If a relay team breaks a British record, the team will collectively receive one share of the prize fund.

If a European or World record is broken, it will still count as a single British record for the purposes of the prize fund.

RECORDS

If you break a record, please complete the application form available from the medal table as soon as possible after the swim and hand it to the promoters so that the appropriate signatures can be obtained.

Claiming a record after the meet may not be possible if the paperwork is not completed at the time.

SWIM ENGLAND TRANSGENDER AND NON-BINARY COMPETITION POLICY

Swim England has updated its Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy and this became effective on 1st September 2023. All Swim England affiliated bodies are required to implement this policy.

Under the policy competitions, such as this meet, where the results will be submitted to Rankings must be held with the following categories:

Female – Swimmers with a birth sex of female and categorised as female in the Swim England on-line membership system.

Or

Open/Male – Swimmers with a birth sex of male, Trans or non-binary swimmers and any swimmers not eligible for the female category.

For the avoidance of doubt, swimmers eligible for the new Female category may not enter the Open/Male category.

PHOTOGRAPHY

By submitting an entry, entrants are accepting that their photograph and video images may be taken and used to promote future Kenilworth Masters' events.

LIMITS OF LIABILITY

In any situation that the meet must be cancelled competitors are not automatically eligible to a full refund of their entry fees. Proportionate refunds may be made but only after the promoter has covered all incurred costs.

PERSONAL DECLARATION

By submitting my on-line entry, I certify that I am physically fit to participate in this event. I am aware of the need to seek appropriate medical advice if I have any concerns as to the state of my health. I have not been informed by any medical practitioner and I do not have any knowledge of any medical condition which would make it inadvisable for me to participate in Masters Swimming events and any other associated activities.

I also confirm that by entering that:

- I am currently registered as a competitive swimmer and my registration number is as provided in the on-line entry form
- I have read and understand the Conditions listed in this document and accept them
- I am a member of the club for which I have entered
- My date of birth and my entry times declared are correct
- My entry category complies with the Female or Open/Male category as described above
